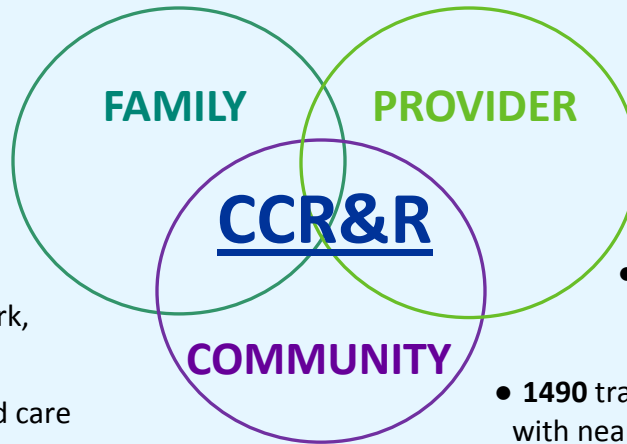
2009 Annual Highlights

CONNECTING FAMILIES WITH CHILD CARE SERVICES

- **11,010** families received customized referrals
- **26,563** families received technical assistance about child care, child development, parenting, or a referral to another community resource

Families have the opportunity to learn about:

- the attributes of high quality early care and education
- regulated child care options in or near their residence, place of work, child's school, etc.
- local and statewide rates for child care



SERVING CHILD CARE PROVIDERS

- **24,025** potential child care providers received technical assistance
- **460** start-up/recruitment sessions were offered for group centers and family providers
- **3,498** sessions of intense technical consulting were provided
- **4,941** site visits were made to potential and existing child care programs
- **60,081** existing family providers and group centers received technical assistance
- **1490** training opportunities were offered with nearly **21,000** participants attending

CONNECTING CHILDREN TO HIGH QUALITY CHILD CARE

- **15,840 WI children** were served through referrals to families at no or low-cost
- **59%** referrals for infants or toddlers
- **19%** referrals for pre-school-aged children
- **22%** referrals for school-aged children
- **1.3%** referrals for children identified by their parents as having special needs

SERVING COMMUNITIES

- Serving all **72 counties** in WI
- Serving all **11 Tribes** in WI
- Employers were contacted 7,658 times regarding early care and education
- Actively participated in over 800 community meetings related to early childhood
- Collaborated at over 1300 community building meetings
